My dear Dr.Bey.

To day we received a letter from Prof.Duggan,saying that a letter from Dr.Patrick made it known that you took up a position in Egypt,as High Commisioner,and that you gave up the original plan of coming to this country.

But at the same time an other letter from Selma Hanım, which we received also today,gives us the understanding that your wife and Nazif went to Egypt to join you and then you would sail for America as soon as possible . However I have not heard from you directly , to enable myself for a true judgement as to your right attitude,it is exceedingly difficult for me to what to say to Prof.Duggan. I think you are treating this case rather too Oriental manner,specially if you really intend to come to this country,you should deal with Prof.Duggan more consideringly, as you know very well that without his Institutions' help it will be very perplexing for three of you to land in New York,as this is contrary to the present emigration law in America.

I do not understand why you did not write to us,or to Prof.Duggan regarding your delay in coming to this country,or what ever your intention is for the future. And most specially,would not that be more beneficial for you and your family to come directly to America, instead going to Hedjaz, if you were here once,it would be easy for you to fix up the way to get your family here without suffering just as they did now; it would be easy for me to go to Constantinople to help them get ready to start for America,and by that time you would have earned enough money here to provide every confort that you wished to give them.

Strange it is,how you wanted to get yourself in difficult angles, but at any rate,if you manage to get this dilemma over, I very earnestly hope that better times will be yours; however, if at the same time,you wish to stay out of poletics. I do not think poletic did any good to you, as the present result is a bad witness , so why not forsake the practice of it then ? .If not for the sake of peace, let it be so for the sake of your family,there is no use of going any further than those who wanted to be the champion of a stiff opposition to the Angora regime,they are all quietly living in comfortable quarters in Europe,or in other places . To my rather Americanized mind,it looks,that the only logical course left to persist , is to accept the "coup" gamely, and do what is popular among the people. American poleticians are great,because they are not a bunch of die-harders, consequently their country is also great and prosperous. In the meantime I want to ask you to let me know a week in advance , if you sail from Egypt to this land,so I might be able to do what is necessary to facilitate your landing here upon your arrival.
