My Dear Doctor,

I have been going into your case again during the last few days and find with great regret that neither the Pension Law at present in force, nor the Law in regard to Ottoman Service Pensions which the Secretary of State is ready to agree to permit of the payment to you of a pension.

2. You cannot draw a pension under the Trans-Jordan Law of 1924, because you are not a Trans-Jordanian within the meaning of Article 7 of that Law, neither can you draw a pension under the draft Law referred to above on account of your former Ottoman Service, because the interval between that Service and your Trans-Jordan Service is greater than one year, and, because you have not completed 10 years service under the Trans-Jordan Government.

3. With the best will in the world I am unable to call upon the Trans-Jordan Government to grant you a pension when the conditions of your service are such that the law does not allow that a pension be paid.

4. I spoke to Sir John Shuckburgh, some time ago, regarding the possibility of the British Treasury paying you a pension, and he did not hold out any hope at all that this would be possible. Nevertheless, I am ready, if you desire me to do so, to make out as strong a case as possible in your favour with that end in view, but will not do so until I have heard from you what your wishes are.

5. When the Executive Council was recently re-organised, His Highness the Amir promised me that he would set apart the monthly sum of £P:25 for you from his Civil List.

I have, to-day, handed a letter on this subject to His Highness saying that the only solution I can see to this difficult problem is that he should continue to allow you this monthly sum until such time as your sons are in a position to support you and their mother.



Sir,

In reply to your despatch No.39^M of 25th March,
I have the honour to submit herewith a copy of the
decision of the Juridical Sub-Committee of Sanitary
Liquidation Commission which appears to deprive Dr.
Riza Tewfic of his right to any share in the reserve
fund of the former International Sanitary Board. I
shall be glad to know whether the decision is based
on equitable grounds or whether you are of the opinion
that further representations should be made.

2. I would add that the Liquidation Commission
will conclude its labour on 1st June and is pre-
paring to leave Constantinople on 15th June. Any
representations would therefore have to be made
with considerable urgency as the funds are being
rapidly disbursed to accepted claimants.

My dear Doctor,


I have considered your note to me regarding the £ 73 which you were called upon to pay. I have also seen the report of the Special Committee which was formed at my request to decide whether the money should be recovered from you or should be written off. The Committee found that you are responsible for the missing money because no proof exists that the cheque was cashed by the Chief Clerk of the Public Health Department or any other person, and because neither the voucher nor the cheque bear any signature other than yours, and because you personally collected the cheque and signed the voucher in the Finance Ministry

I am of course convinced, and I am sure the Board is of the same opinion, that you did not take the money, but at the same time you certainly were neglectful in not ascertaining that the money was properly disposed of especially in view of the fact that the refusal of the Finance Ministry to hand the cheque to your Chief Clerk and that they insisted on paying it direct to you, might be taken as an indication that the Chief Clerk was not to be trusted with so large a sum.

I am very sorry that you should be the one to suffer, but the Government is bound to protect the public funds by calling on those who are technically responsible to make good a loss when such a loss occurs.

work is found to be enormous in
the beginning but later on as
steads of depth and garrus

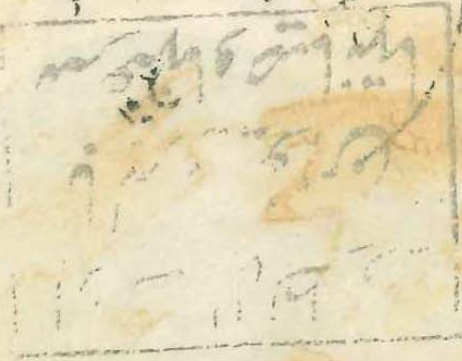

As a close student of the affairs in course of development in the Near East and as one desirous of seeing peace established in that unhappy land, permit me to suggest, through your valuable columns, a scheme of solution deserving the serious attention of those intimately related to the welfare of that region. It must be evident to the Greeks by this time that the advent of Constantine into the Near Eastern diplomacy was an event of most unhappy portent. * * * It is equally evident that Kemal Pasha is unable to evict the Grecian troops from the environs of Smyrna, which is really the only bone of contention. Now if we exclude the military forces of both Turkish and Greek nationality from this region and substitute for its government police forces from the United States, France, Great Britain and Italy and declare Smyrna a free port, we will have a very good approximation to a satisfactory settlement.



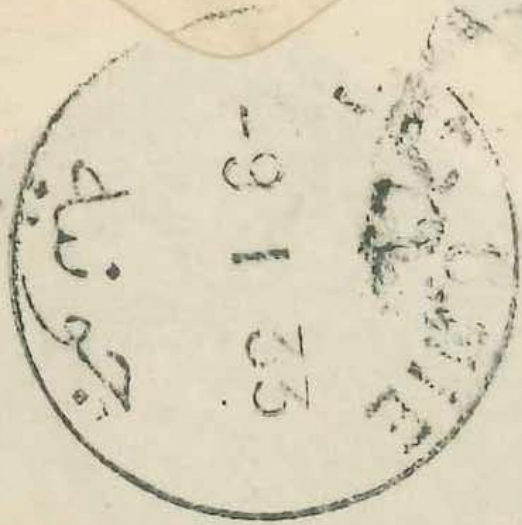

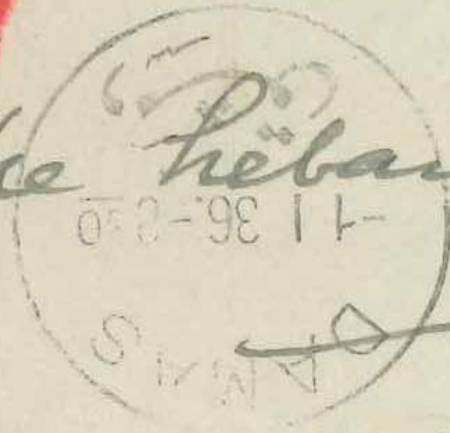
