Dear Dr. Rıza Tevfik,

I have just received  
your letter and am exceedingly  
~~very~~ glad you should be so troubled.  
Let me first of all reassure you  
as to Said. Immediately  
after the incident, which I heard  
of at once, I questioned him  
and he apparently did not  
attribute much importance  
to it. Then he went home  
in a few days. I have just

seen him again & he says he  
is perfectly well. There are no  
bad results of what happened &  
I feel sure you need not be  
anxious.

Next I must apologise for the  
action of the master responsible.  
There is no defence, and I can  
only account for it by supposing  
that the master lost his head  
in a moment of extreme  
irritation. He tells me  
however that he had no

idea, at the time or afterwards,  
that what he did could have  
any important result. I may  
say also that he is a master  
who is much respected by  
the boys and controls them  
easily, which makes the  
incident all the more regrettable  
and difficult to explain.

Naturally I have reprimanded  
him seriously & I hope you  
will kindly excuse him. I  
am sure there will be no  
repetition of such unfortunate
